

Results from the alcohol permit renewal inspection conducted on Tuesday, December 3, 2024, at United Liquor, located at 800 Pierre Ave.

Please find enclosed 7/14 photos that I intend to offer into evidence at the hearing scheduled for Monday, February 10, 2025.

Further information and clarification regarding these images are listed below:

1. **Drug Paraphernalia:** Behind the counter, I observed packaging material commonly associated with drugs, as well as glass pipes, which, based on my training and experience, appeared to be crack pipes. These items were hidden under the register, likely in an attempt to conceal them. The clerk claimed the paraphernalia was old; however, I reminded him that the owner had previously received a warning for similar violations during a prior inspection.
2. **Sanitary Ordinance Violations:**
  - A strong, unpleasant odor was present inside the store, accompanied by flying bugs, which appeared to be gnats.
  - A large, filthy city trashcan was positioned next to the ice maker inside the store.
  - The sink was covered with black soot or mold, and trash was present inside it.
  - Access to the bathroom was blocked.
  - The cooler doors had visible black mold, and the floor inside the walk-in cooler was sticky. Trash was scattered throughout, and mold was also observed on the shelves where beverages were stored for customer purchase.
3. **Exterior Conditions:** Trash was strewn across the ground in front of and on the side of the business.
