**PURPOSE**

To allow the City to proceed with the purchase of insurance coverage for the policy year beginning April 1, 2025.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Most of the City's liability and casualty insurance is purchased for a calendar year beginning April 1. For the past several months, City staff and Alliant, the City's insurance advisors, have been working to obtain the best possible coverage at the most reasonable prices. This resolution authorizes the purchases of our various insurance policies and provides the most current estimate of pricing. The estimated cost of \$9,994,129 is about 9% more than was estimated at this time last year. However, the total is likely to be reduced somewhat between now and the April 1 purchase date. Updated pricing information will be amended into this resolution before final passage. Several of our coverages, particularly commercial property coverage, will be available at a lower price in 2025, but there is a significant increase in the estimated cost for casualty coverage, mostly due to increasing costs for auto liability coverage. Alliant believes that the current estimate will come down somewhat before coverage is actually purchased on April 1. Even at the current estimate, the premium amounts are within the amounts contained in the 2025 Retained Risk budget.

The Mayor, City Attorney, Risk Manager and Director of Finance have been involved in this process and recommend approval.
