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PURPOSE

To authorize Mayor to execute an agreement with Stryker Sales Corporation for service and maintenance on fifteen (15) Lifepak 15 monitor/defibrillators owned and operated by the Shreveport Fire Department.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Shreveport Fire Department owns and operates fifteen (15) Lifepak 15 monitor/defibrillators purchased from Stryker Sales Corporation, a sole source provider. The units require regular service and maintenance to remain operational. The proposed service and maintenance agreement is for a four-year term at an annual cost of \$33,060.00. Stryker will provide onsite preventive maintenance, off site repair, parts, labor, software updates, loaner devices, and battery replacement services.

RESOLUTION NO. 12 OF 2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH STRYKER SALES CORPORATION, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

BY:

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport Fire Department owns and operates fifteen (15) Lifepak 15 monitor/defibrillators purchased from Stryker Sales Corporation (Stryker), a sole source provider; and

WHEREAS, the LifePak 15 units require regular service and maintenance to remain operational; and

WHEREAS, Stryker provides the required service and maintenance and proposes to offer those services to the City of Shreveport Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Stryker and the City of Shreveport Fire Department desire to contract for service and maintenance of the Life Pak 15 units for a four (4) year period at an annual cost of \$33,060.00;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in due, regular, and legal session convened, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Service and Maintenance Agreement with Stryker Sale Corporation, substantially in accordance with the draft thereof filed for public inspection with the original of this resolution in the Office of the Clerk of Council on December 3, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provisions or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or applications; and, to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
