

**ORDINANCE NO. 119 OF 2024**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10-186 OF THE  
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHREVEPORT  
AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT  
THERE TO.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in due, legal, and regular session convened, that Section 10-186 be hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 10-186. – Security requirements.

\*\*\*

(d) Penalties for failure to meet security requirements. The Chief of Police, in his discretion, shall penalize violators of Section 10-186 as follows:

1. For the initial violation – a warning
2. If the violation persists after 15 days – a fine not to exceed \$500.00
3. If the violation persists after 30 days – suspension of the liquor license for 30 days.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, items, or application of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or application and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
