

ORDINANCE NO. 125 OF 2024

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2025 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SPECIAL REVENUE
FUND BUDGET AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO**

BY: COUNCILMAN GREEN

WHEREAS, Article 7 of the Charter of the City of Shreveport requires the adoption of a comprehensive operating budget for the year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has created the Community Development Special Revenue Fund, to account for certain funds spent on job training, housing improvements, and neighborhood development.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The 2025 budget for the Community Development Fund is \$18,917,800 which is a decrease of 22% from the 2024 budget. The budget includes \$1,970,000 subsidy and grants match from the General Fund and \$231,300 in Riverfront funding. Most of these funds are federal and state grants and will be spent on housing, business development, special programs and workforce investment opportunities programs.
