

RESOLUTION NO. 159 OF 2024

A RESOLUTION DEDICATING THE 700 BLOCK OF TURNER LANE IN HONOR OF PASTOR LOVELLE BUTLER AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO

WHEREAS, Pastor Lovelle Butler has been a part of the City of Shreveport since November 2007; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Butler started as a Chaplin in prison ministry and later transitioned to a traveling evangelist; and

WHEREAS, he took to the streets alongside other ministry leaders going to different neighborhoods to empower and encourage citizens in the community; and

WHEREAS, seeing the needs of the community led him to start New Love Restoration Church, which has expanded into two locations; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Butler is over countless outreach programs, such as local giveaways, food and clothing drives and he also serves as the voice regarding the needs of the community as youth and senior advocate; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Butler has proven to be a driving force within the city and continues to strive to make the city a better and safer place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in due regular and legal session convened, that the Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized to dedicate the 700 block of Turner Lane, in honor of Pastor Lovelle Butler.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with Resolution No. 156 of 2019, the dedication marker should be approximately 9 inches tall and 42 inches wide and should be placed on an existing standard or street sign if the placement is authorized by Traffic Engineering.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
