SPONSOR**PURPOSE**

The purpose is to increase funding for Citywide Water Infrastructure - E21001 by \$3,724,100.

Background Information

This ordinance will increase Citywide Water Infrastructure – E21001 by \$3,724,100. The funding sources will be \$3,351,700 from the Hazard Mitigation Grant and \$372,400 from W&S Revenue. These funds will be incorporated into the W&S Capital Improvement Budget to install a generator at 2 vital booster pump stations (BPS): McNeil BPS, which mainly serves downtown Shreveport and Barksdale AFB, and Inner Loop BPS, which provides service to SE Shreveport and the Port. Backup generators will satisfy a regulatory requirement to provide power service to these BPS in the events of emergencies.

The \$3,351,700 grant was provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as part of their Hazard Mitigation Grant program to provide funding for eligible long-term solutions that reduce the impact of disasters in the future.
