**A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE LADY RAIDERS OF HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO**

**WHEREAS**, the Lady Raiders' victory also provided other titles to reflect upon: Most Outstanding Player in LHSAA Division I Select Championship Game- Carley Hamilton with 27 points, 8 rebounds, and 4 steals; McDonalds All Americans Jamar'i Bell and Carley Hamilton; 1-5A 1st Team All District Carley Hamilton and Kyndal Graham; 1-5A 2nd Team All District Jamar'i Bell; 1-5A Honorable Mention Kaylie Dupree and Kendal Stevenson; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lady Raiders not only dominated on the court, but also in the classroom with an overall team GPA of 3.8. Jamar'i Bell and Carly Hamilton have worked hard to obtain their Associate's Degree before graduating; and Jamar'i Bell, Carley Hamilton, and Jayla Phillips have been named on the LHSAA All-Academic Class List; and

**WHEREAS**, Coach Brian Shyne and Coach Rickey Evans are 218-44 in 8 years with two State Championships in two different divisions, as well as, two State Runner Ups in two different divisions; and

**WHEREAS**, under the steady leadership of Coaches Brian Shyne, Ricky Evans, and Kesha McClendon, the Lady Rebels developed a mature, determined approach to their game—an approach enhanced by their natural talent, focus, commitment, and pride. The result was a team that calmly and steadily did what was needed to win their games and, ultimately, the Division I Select State Championship
