Dear Mr. Mohammad Khan

Mr. Khan, recently you applied for an ABO card. It was noted that you did not qualify for an ABO card due to city ordinance 10-66. This correspondence is to inform you that your application for an ABO card has been denied. The denial is because you do not meet all the requirements as outlined by City Ordinance.

Section 10-66. Qualifications of Applicant.

(1) He/she must be a person of good character and reputation and 18 years of age or older.

(3) He/she has not been convicted in the last two years in this or in any other state or by the United States or any other country of soliciting for prostitution, pandering, letting premises for prostitution, contributing to the delinquency of juveniles, keeping a disorderly place, letting a disorderly place, illegally dealing in controlled dangerous substances or any violation of the controlled dangerous substance statute.

(5) Have not been convicted of a felony under the laws of the United States, the state of Louisiana, or any other state or country.

RS 40:967 – Prohibited Acts- Schedule II

C. Possession. It is unlawful for any person knowingly or intentionally to possess a controlled dangerous substance as classified in Schedule II unless such substance was obtained directly or pursuant to a valid prescription or order from a practitioner, as provided in R.S. 40:978 while acting in the course of his professional practice, or except as otherwise authorized by this Part. Any person who violates this Subsection with respect to:

D. If the applicant's business is to be conducted wholly or partly by one or more managers, agents, servants, employees, or other representatives, those persons shall also possess the qualifications required of the applicant and shall furnish verification of suitability in accordance with Paragraph (H)(6) of this Section; however, convicted felons may be employed by an applicant if, in the applicant's business, alcoholic beverages are not the principal commodities sold, handled, or given away.

Disposition:

Mr. Khan has multiple charges for DUI and possession and is currently a convicted felon. Due to his criminal history, he has been denied an ABO card in the past. Additionally, Mr. Khan was arrested for working without an ABO card and pled no contest to the charge earlier this year. His past actions reflect poorly on his character and reputation.


If you disagree with the decision of the Shreveport Police Department, you can call the City Council office
