PURPOSE

The City of Shreveport's goal is to amend the automated speed enforcement system agreement to include additional automated speed enforcement cameras in non-school zone and to extend the term of the agreement for three years.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Currently, the Blue Line Solutions, LLC has only deployed automated speed enforcement systems in school zones. In order to deploy these systems to additional areas within the City that are not school zones, Blue Lines Solutions, LLC will have to advance additional funding. In consideration for the expansion of the systems, the parties seek to extend the term of the existing agreement.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BLUE LINE SOLUTIONS, LLC TO ADD ADDITIONAL AUTOMATED SPEED ENFORCMENT CAMERAS IN NON-SCHOOL ZONES AND EXTEND THE AGREEMENT TERM, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, Blue Line Solutions, LLC (herein “BLS”) and the City of Shreveport entered into that certain Automated Speed Enforcement System Agreement (“the Agreement”) on February 2, 2022, which became effective in November of 2022, with a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, crashes caused by speeding vehicles are a contributing factor to injuries and fatalities within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to add additional automated speed enforcement cameras in non-school zone areas; and

WHEREAS, as an incentive for BLS to install the additional cameras, the City of Shreveport and BLS agree that the term of the Agreement should be extended for three (3) years beginning _____, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Tom Arceneaux, is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City of Shreveport, any and all documents related to the execution and intent of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications and to this end the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
