#### **PURPOSE**

To allow the Mayor to sign the documents necessary for the City to receive a State grant of \$5,840,250 for water system improvements.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City has received notice that it has been approved for a State grant of \$5,840,250 for water system improvements. These funds are part of the funds the State received from the Federal government for COVID recovery. Shreveport will use those funds to clean, rehabilitate and repair two of the City's aboveground water tanks (St. Vincent and West Shreveport) and the ground storage tank at 70<sup>th</sup> and Pines Road, to provide generators at four booster pumps stations and to construct a water main extension that the State wants us to build to allow us to serve the customers of the Lake Shreve water system. The overall cost is estimated at approximately \$15,840,000. Water and sewer funds will pay the remaining costs.
